St Xavier's chain of schools at Bilaspur region is committed for holistic education through unique pedagogy for overall development of the child from the Montessori level itself. We invite the kids at the pre-schooling age group at child development center to lay the stepping stone for motor development by proven systems and methods of international standards. A child develops in stress-free environment and acquires the skills in both scholastic and non-scholastic areas through qualified teachers and trainers. The Montessori classes (beginning with pre-mont till mont III) helps our child to adjust and fare better in primary classes because of early preparation and acquaintance with school atmosphere.

THE BOARDING FACILITY

"Home away from Home".

The school takes pride in closely monitoring the educational and emotional well-being of each and every student. The school takes such excellent care of the children that the word "home sickness" ceases to exist in their vocabularies. The school has separate, well furnished rooms for boys and girls. They are aesthetically designed with optimum convenience. The rooms in hostels are strategically located to ensure that the children have easy access to the class rooms and the dining hall. Each dormitory is run under the care of a dorm-master who keeps a close watch on the physical health and academic progress of the students. A matron-in-charge supervises the other routine work regarding cleanliness and laundry. Making boarding fun are the week end outing, excursion and in-campus activities like games, dance and different competitions.

TO PARENTS OF ALL BOARDERS

1. A list of articles should be pasted on the inside lid of the trunk and a duplicate copy handed over to the Matron.

2. The school cannot arrange for the safe keeping of any valuables, therefore it is desired that the student does not bring any expensive items (eg. jewellery, cell phones, MP3s/4s, Video games, cassette players, walkmans, transistors, costly pens or watches) with him / her.

3. No pocket money should be given to the children. They will have a book account with the school office, and expenses if any (e.g. tuck purchase) would be charged to parents at the end of the term. Cash left over from the journey from home to school should be handed over by the students to the resident dorm parent immediately on entry into the dorm. The cash shall be credited to the student's personal account. The withdrawal of money would be monitored and controlled for obvious reasons.

4. Any expensive item or cash, if found with the student thereafter, shall be confiscated and donated to charity.

5. For any child under treatment prior to admission, medicines sent by parents will be administered by the consultant doctor/ resident nurses. Prescriptions must accompany all medicines. No child will be permitted to keep medicines in the dormitory .



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All fees must be paid on schedule time.
- 2. Parents/ Guardians cannot enter the dormitories. They should report to the school office. The student, with per mission from the Warden / Matron, would then be allowed to meet the visitors in the office.
- 3. No boarder would be allowed out of the school without a written authorization note from the parent. Kindly make sure to mention a contact telephone number in your letter (or an E-mail id / fax no)
- 4. Parents / Guardians are permitted to meet their wards on stipulated day of each month only with prior permission of the Principal. No other person is allowed to meet the students. They are not allowed to enter the dormitories or the class rooms.

KNOW THE

RULES

- 5. Parents will not be allowed to take their wards out of the hostel during working days
- 6. No request to send children with an escort or by themselves would be entertained.
- 7. Students would not be permitted to make phone calls during weekdays. However, messages would be received and passed on to their wards only under extraordinary circumstances. Phone calls could be made by parents on weekends.
- 8. Expenses towards ticket (Air / Rail / Road) and escort must be paid in advance to the school office before a request for booking/s is / are made to the school office.
- 9. All students must follow the daily programme which includes getting up on time and participation in meditation and prayer. This is compulsory and without exception.
- 10. Prep time in the morning must be used to go through the lessons (subject wise) that are planned for the day. The evening prep time on the other hand should be used for completion of homework (subject wise). Walking around and talking in the study hall is not permitted.
- 11. Uniform/s as specified must be worn by all.
 - (This includes not just the school uniform but also uniforms on the sports fields).
- 12. Wearing of blazers is compulsory for all students (for all school functions).
- 13. All boarders must assemble outside the hostel during evening after laying time.. Roll call would be taken before morning and Evening Prep.
- 14. Wearing borrowed clothes is forbidden.
- 15. Laundry clothes should be left in the laundry bag on the due day. No clothes will be accepted after the due date.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 16. Boys hair must be short enough so they do not cover the ears or fall across the forehead, or cover the shirt collar.
- 17. Girls with shoulder length hair must tie them up with ribbons.
- 18. Small ear studs are to be worn only by the girls. No chains, rings and other earrings are allowed to be worn by either girls or boys. Boarders should not bring in jewellery, except a pair of studs (not rings or drops) to be worn only by girl students.
- 19. The girls shall not bring any dress that is sleeveless and / or transparent.
- 20. Children who do not look after their belongings would warrant disciplinary action.
- 21. Girls should not move out of their hostel without a lady escort at all times.
- 22. Movement about the school, especially in the corridors should be orderly keeping to the right hand side and with out making any noise
- 23. Do not write on or disfigure the walls, or cause damage to furniture's (desks/cots/ cupboards), sanitary fittings etc., a fine would be levied which would include the cost of replacing the damaged item. Repeated occurrence would lead to strong action.
- 24. Theft would be treated seriously. Any student found guilty of it, would be immediately suspended and may be per manently expelled. Suspension would be awarded only by the Principal after a proper enquiry. Reporting of a theft must be immediate.
- 25. Leaving the school premises without the permission of the Principal is prohibited. Students found outside the school premises without the permission of the Principal could be expelled on the spot and parents asked to take away the student.
- 26. A healthy relationship between boys and girls is encouraged. Unhealthy relationship between boys and girls will not be tolerated and the offender / offenders will be immediately dealt with, with punishment that could also include ex pulsion.
- 27. Students would be permitted to bring only one set of colour clothes, which may be worn on the student's birthday. On all other days the student should conform to the stipulated dress code. Rules applicable to senior students (Besides rules 1 to 27)
- 28. Possession of tobacco, cigarettes or any other addictive substance, would result in expulsion of the student.
- 29. Any form of Aggression, Rowdyism, and Manhandling of juniors may result in very strict disciplinary action.
- 30. Repeated failure to comply with rules and regulations and any form of in subordination with school / dorm staff may result in expulsion.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The minimum age for admission to Montessori - I is 2 years 6 months as on 1st of April of the year of admission. As a proof of age birth certificate from the municipality must be submitted.

Admission is subject to the availability of seats and fitness of the candidates. Registration starts in the month of January for Montessori I, II and III. Admission to Grade I to Grade IX depends upon the efficiency of the child during the entrance test. Every candidate who is registered is given the date and time for the entrance test. Admission to all the classes closes by 30th April. In the interest of pupil's attendance, parents are advised to complete all admission/readmission formalities by the end of April every year.

MERE REGISTRATION IS NO GUARANTEE FOR ADMISSION

At the time of admission (for Classes I to IX) along with application form, a photocopy of the original birth certificate and original transfer certificate from the school last attended, counter signed by the Block Education Officer (BEO) and the most recent (original) report card is to be submitted. Apart from the various prescribed fees payable during an academic year, parents should pay annual charges at the beginning of every academic year.
