**Planets**

Planets are large natural objects that orbit, or travel around, stars. Eight planets orbit the star called the Sun. In order from the closest to the Sun, these planets are Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune. The solar system is the collection of the Sun and the objects that orbit around it, including the eight planets.

Planets differ from other objects such as comets, asteroids, and meteors. In general, planets are the largest objects in the solar system after the Sun. Most of them orbit the Sun in a path that is almost like a circle. They also have an atmosphere, or a layer of gases surrounding them. Most of the planets have at least one moon.

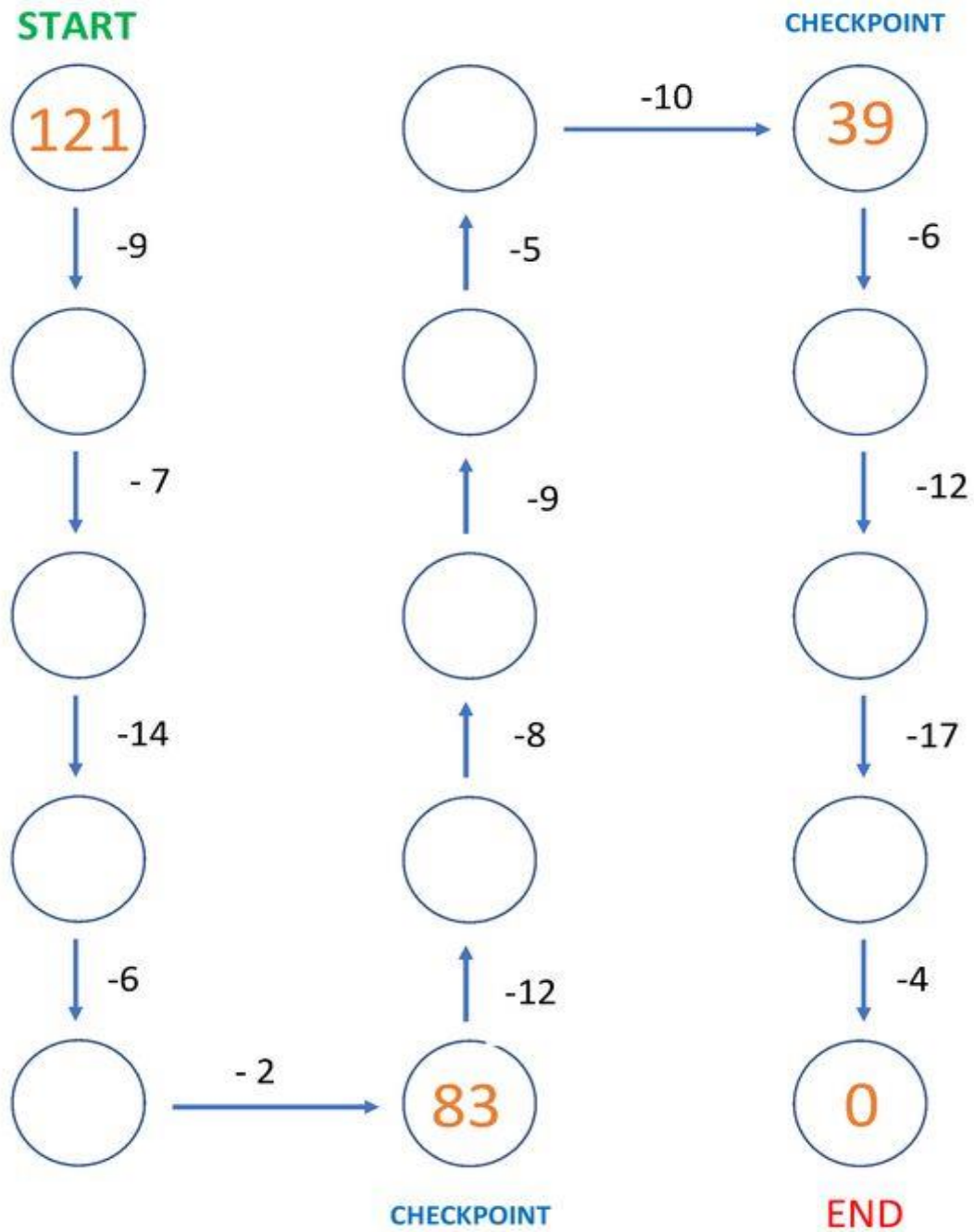


# **MATHEMATICS**

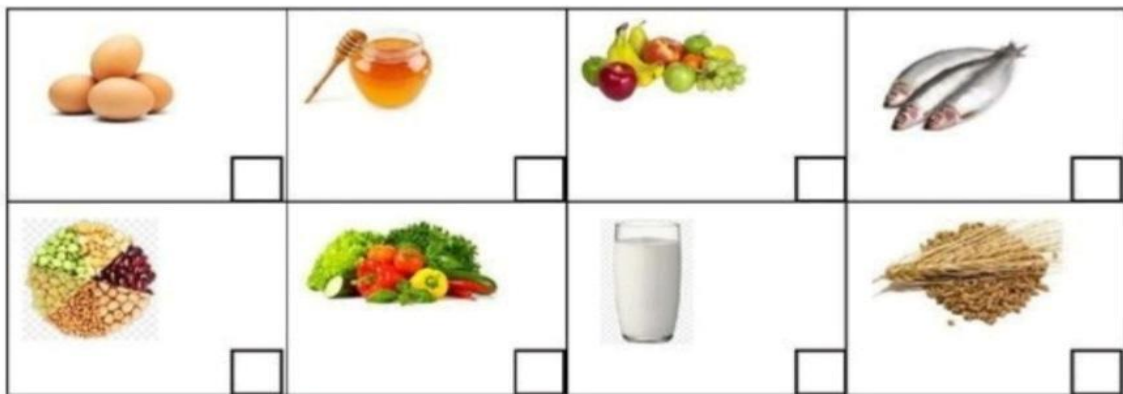
